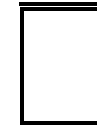
Key Features



1. A range of wall heights vary the amount of privacy and enclosure of workstations, allowing you to create configurations that range from traditional to collaborative.
2. Frames accept tiles in several materials, including: fabric, laminate, veneer, and tackable.
3. Overhead storage makes the most of vertical space.
4. Lower storage provides places for work and personal items. It can support a wall and provides secondary seating.
5. Screens can be transparent to allow visual access or solid to indicate boundary.
6. Power and data can be routed vertically every 11 inches of the frame height, and horizontally through connecting frames.

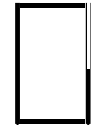
